

Dear Tenants:

The Arizona Department of Transportation is beginning the long-anticipated Lindsay Road Interchange project which will provide direct freeway access to Gilbert's Central Business District, improve traffic flow in the area by widening Lindsay Road, and reduce traffic congestion at the existing interchanges at Gilbert Road and Val Vista Drive.

Starting Tuesday, March 2, construction related to the infrastructure improvements will briefly impact traffic patterns in the immediate area. Please note the nearby ramp closures and lane restrictions and their timelines as outlined by ADOT below:

Off-Ramps | Beginning Tuesday, March 2

- The eastbound Loop 202 off-ramp at Val Vista Drive will be closed from 11:30 p.m. Tuesday, March 2, until 5 a.m. Wednesday, March 3.
 - Detour: Drivers can exit at Santan Village Parkway.
- The westbound Loop 202 off-ramp at Gilbert Road will be closed from 11:30 p.m. Thursday, March 4, until 5 a.m. Friday, March 5, and 11:30 p.m. Friday, March 5, until 8 a.m. Saturday, March 6.
 - Detour: Drivers can exit at Cooper Road.

Loop 202 | Beginning Tuesday, March 2

- Eastbound Loop 202 will be restricted to two lanes from Lindsay Road to Val Vista Drive from 11:30 p.m. Tuesday, March 2, until 5 a.m. Wednesday, March 3.
- Westbound Loop 202 will be restricted to two lanes from Lindsay to Gilbert roads from 11:30 p.m. Thursday, March 4, until 5 a.m. Friday, March 5, and 11:30 p.m. Friday, March 5, until 8 a.m. Saturday, March 6.

Lindsay Road | Beginning Tuesday, March 9

- Lindsay Road will be restricted to one lane in each direction between Pecos and Germann Roads beginning Tuesday, March 9 for the duration of the project.

We appreciate your patience as improvements are implemented. Please remember to use caution and drive safely around construction personnel and equipment during this time.
